Please note: we will be ensuring we comply with all current Washington State mandates for COVID-19, including requiring masks when not eating/drinking. We care about your health and safety.

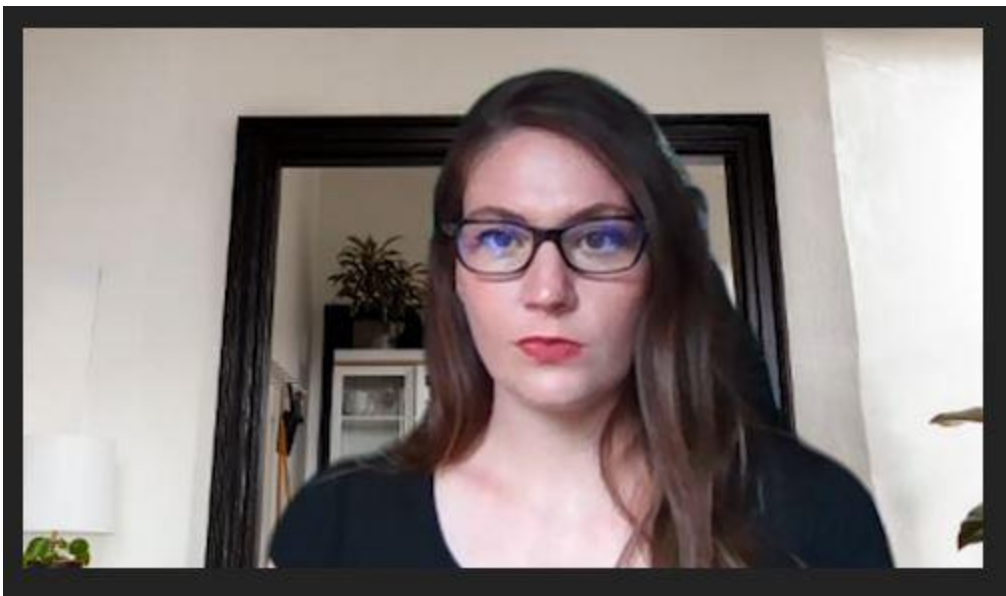

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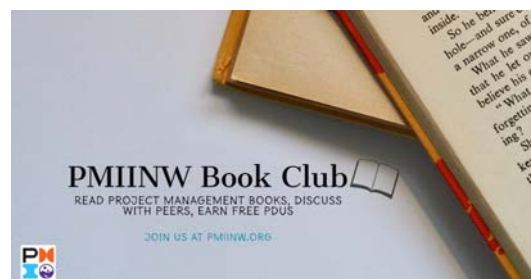
September 14th DA Forum

September 23rd Book Club



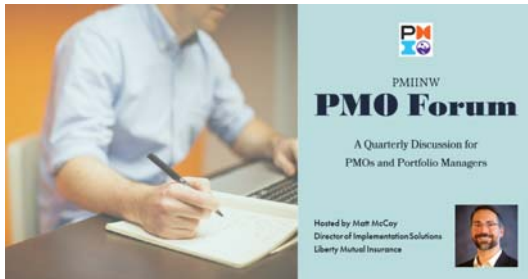
