Disciplined Agile Forum: Where Waterfall Meets Agile- The Avista IT Project Management Way of Working

June's DA Forum will be hosted by a guest speaker: Tony McLaughlin PMP, DASM and IT Project Manager

After receiving his Bachelor's degree in Information Technology, Tony knew that he wanted to be an IT project manager. Being from a technology background, he has 6 technology related certifications that cover hardware, networks, cyber security, Linux, coding, and web design.
